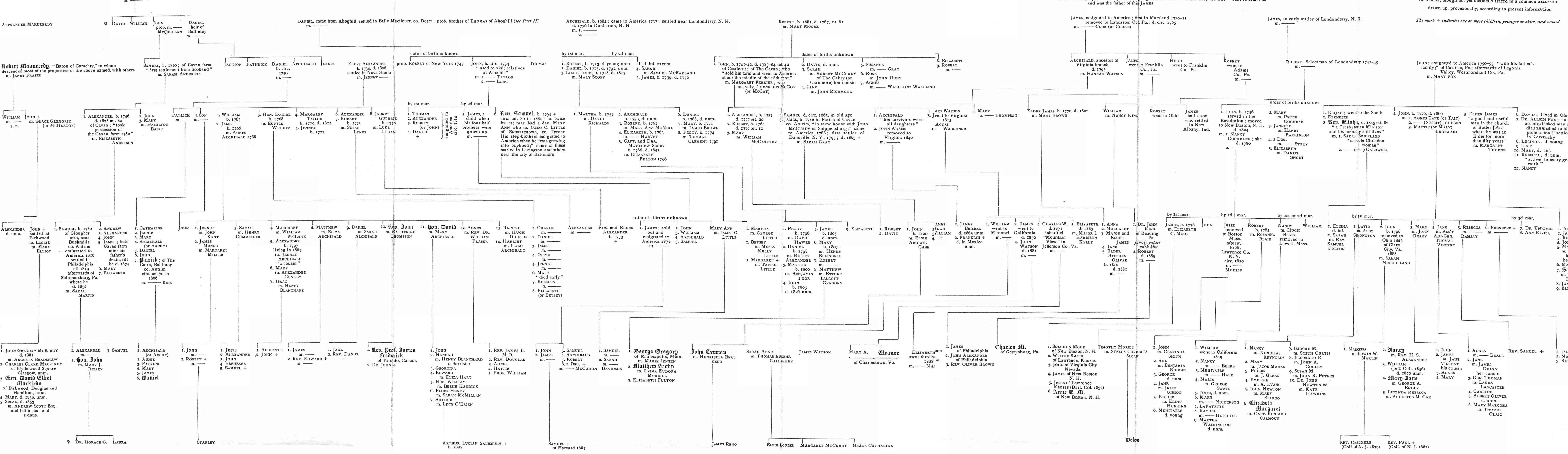

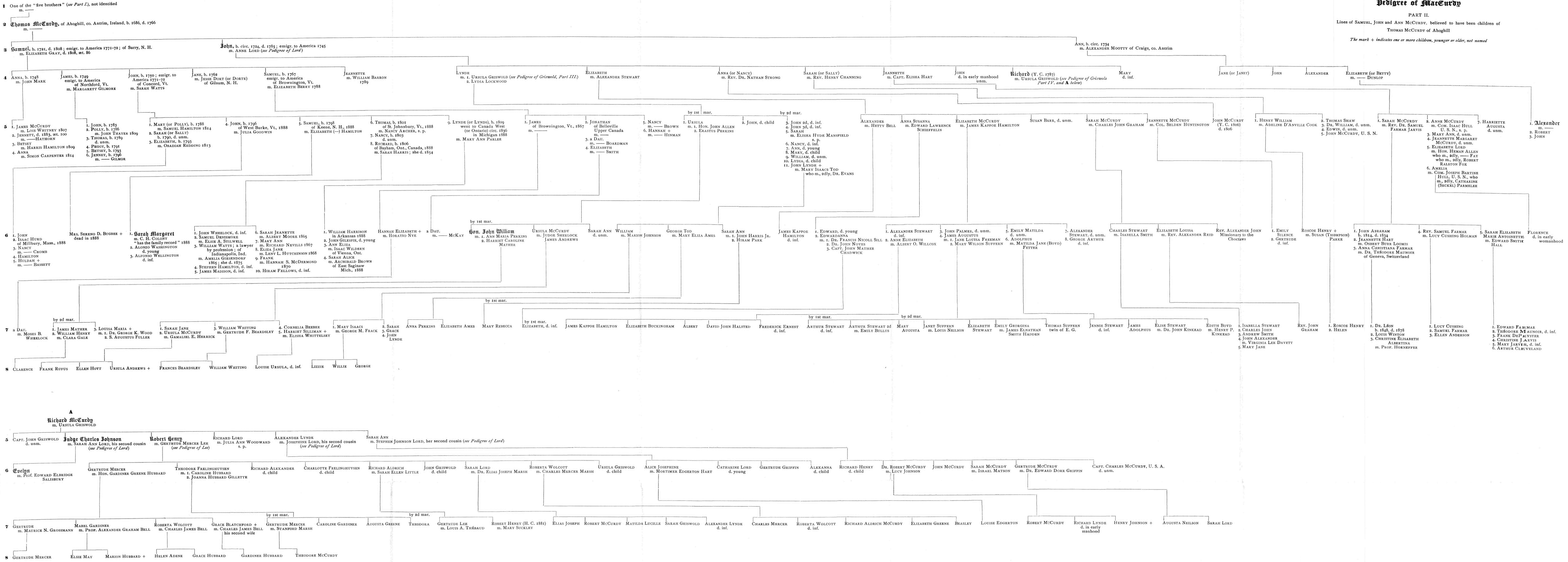


Pedigree of MacCurdy

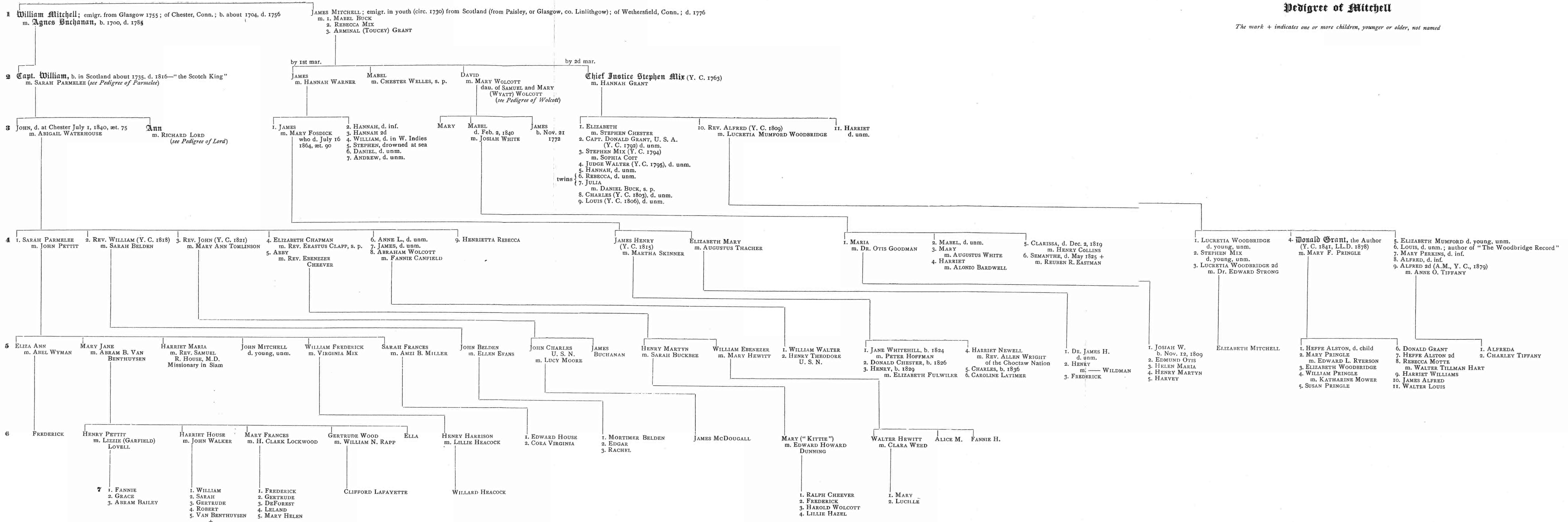

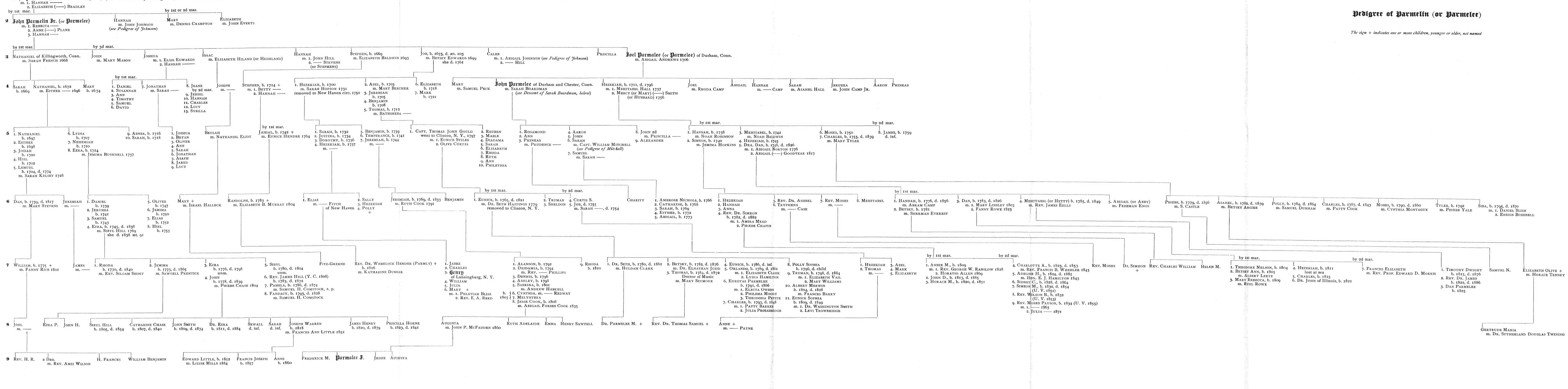

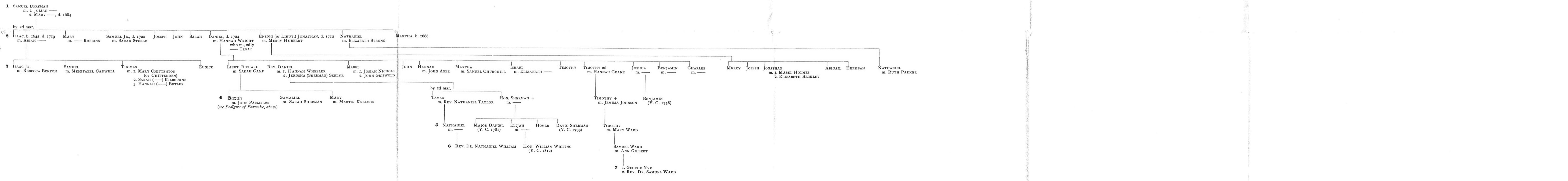

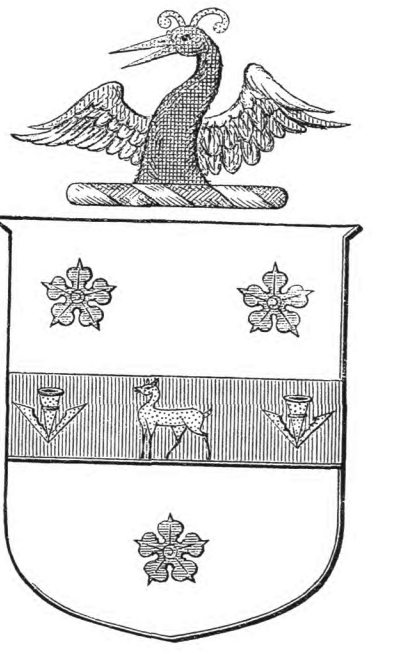
Descent of Sarah Boardman, with some of her collateral Boardman relationships

Pedigree of the Newdigates of Harefield, co. Middlesex and Arbury, co. Warwick, first seated in Surrey

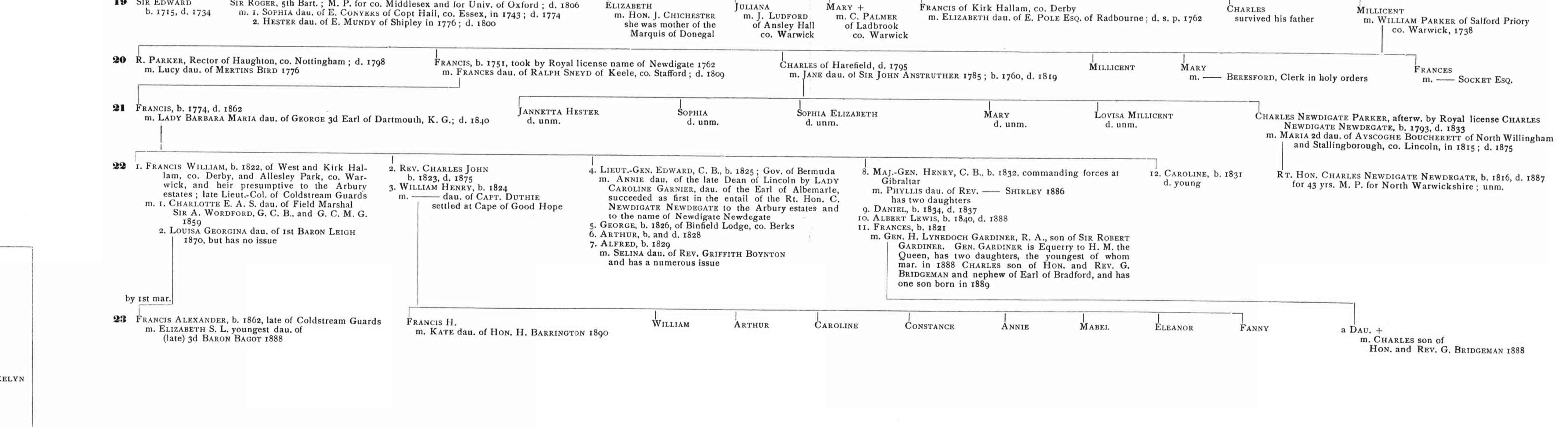


Descent of Joane Hoo, wife of Phillippe Newgate, of the Bedfordshire line

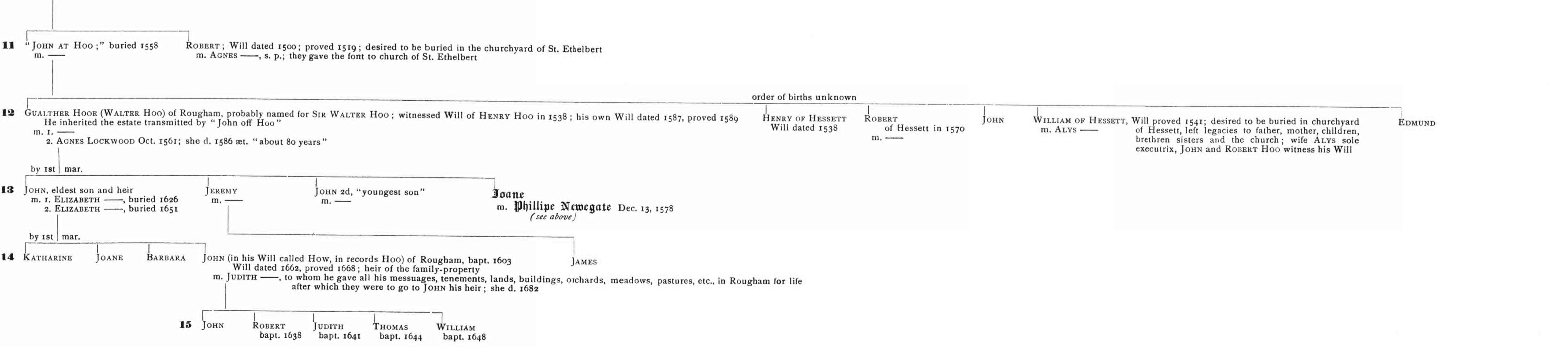

The Favells were settled in very early times in Yorkshire and N. Hants; in the latter county at Walsay, and elsewhere. They were Lords of the Manor of Wotton near Evesham, in the reign of Edward III. when the property passed to the Griffins. The Griffin family was probably of Welsh extraction.
