## P R E F A C E

Born, married, died, and a date after a long forgotten name, is the only record of a vast majority of the people who have lived and moved through the vicissitudes of human existence. Some made but a short visit, and then away; others prolonged their stay but failed to leave any one to bear their name, while others left numerous descendants.

In the good old fashioned days when family bibles were to be found in every well regulated household the parents felt it a religious duty to enter after the record of their marriage the birth of their children, who, in turn recorded the deaths in the family.

The writer has collected a number of these old bibles containing family records and has copied others, which, with a selection from letters and documents in his possession are herewith printed for the use of genealogists and others to whom they may be of interest.

While some of the names and dates have probably been used in compiling family histories, the records herein have not, so far as known, with possible exceptions, ever appeared in print, and are therefore of some value as a source from which genealogical data may be obtained.

Note:-- Gen. Philemon Dickinson, son of Samuel D.  
Dickinson, Chief Justice of the County of Kent, Del.  
and brother of John Dickinson, was born in Crosiadore,  
Talbot County, Md., April 5, 1739. He studied law  
and was admitted to the bar, he also studied medicine.

In July 1775 he entered the Revolutionary army as  
Colonel of the New Jersey militia. He was delegate to  
New Jersey Provincial Congress, 1776, commissioned  
Brigadier General, and June 6, 1777 was made Major  
General of New Jersey forces. Elected delegate to the  
Continental Congress from Delaware 1782 '3. He was  
United States Senator from November 23, 1790, to  
March 3, 1793.

On retiring from public life he returned to his farm  
near Trenton, called the "Hermitage," where he enter-  
tained his friends, and many of the distinguished persons  
passing through Trenton were his guests.

My wife was taken sick in July with a fever and after excruciating illness and patient suffering for six weeks she died on the 9th of the present month. \* \* \*

A few days previous to my wife's being taken sick our little daughter Lucretia was also taken with a fever and after Lingering & pining away with disease she died last friday. Her mother's wish was granted. She while on her deathbed repeatedly said that she should be willing to leave her other children if she could but take her dear little Lucretia with her, \* \* \*

I repine under my affliction and then again when I look upon my three motherless children I know that duty requires me to act with fortitude when they call on me for support and guidance.

\*\*\*\*\* My Father appears to have been born about 1732, though I cannot say exactly, he died at my House 12 Sept. 1808.—aged 76 years.

My Mother was born about 1737, & was Daughter of Pelatiah Mills Esq. of Wintonbury, Cont. She died also at my House 23, Feb y 1810, aged 74.

They had 9 children—all dead but myself.

My Father was Brigadier General of Militia in Vermont, Member of the Council there a long time, and for several years a Judge of the Supreme Court. & Lieutenant Governor for many years till his resignation in 1794.

When a boy I saw my Father's Mother at her son Ezekiel Olcotts in Bolton, 1785, she was then very old & infirm & confined to her bed, has long been dead, but I know not when she died. My other Grandparents I never knew & believe they were then dead.

My Father was a decided Whig during the revolutionary War, but had no opportunity where he resided to be engaged in any of its Battles. He often spoke of the great hardship & fatigue he underwent in some military service to Ticonderoga.

I had 4 Brothers; Pelatiah Mills, Peter, Timothy & Roswell. The two first died in Connecticut. I had 4 sisters, Two of the name of Margaret, one of whom died about 1780.—Sarah & Martha. Sarah married Col Jasper Murdock 1787 & died 1788. The second Margaret married the same Col. Jasper Murdock without issue. My sister Sarah above named had a Daughter

named Sarah Olcott Murdock born June 1788, who married the late Hon. George Blake of Boston—both are dead.

My sister Martha married Ben Porter, a lawyer of Newbury, Vermont, both dead, leaving Children, Timothy Olcott, Ben, Martha, Sarah Olcott, Wm. T. George & Francis Thompson.

I was born in Norwich, Vt. 21, May 1774 & married Sarah Porter the 15, December 1800. She was born 16, March 1777. & was the Daughter of Col. Asa Porter of Haverhill, N. H. both her Parents dead.

Ann Comstock was born Nov r 27, 1796.

Elvira Smith, daughter of Perry & Ann Smith, was born June 23, AD 1816.

John Comstock Smith, son of Perry & Ann Smith, was born July 24, 1820.

Perry Smith was born May 12, 1783, in the town of Washington, Litchfield County, Ct., about a quarter of a mile westerly from where The Mallery family was murdered.

Perry Smith died June 9th 1852.

Ann Smith wife of Perry Smith died Frby 26, 1826,  $\frac{1}{2}$  after 10, o'clock, A. M. Sunday of the Typhus fever.

Elvira Smith, died September 12, 1836,  $\frac{1}{2}$  after 4 o'clock P. M. the disease of which she died, was supposed to be a kind of Consumption, though not supposed to be settled upon the lungs.

John Comstock Smith Died In Crawfordville Montgomery County, State of Indiana. On 18, day of Feb, 1874, on thursday morning 5 o'clock of the Consumption of the blood. Aged 43 years, Seven months, And 6 days.

Mary Isadore Smith oldest daughter of John C. Smith died in Vineland, New Jersey, on March 28, 1892 of blood consumption in 42, year of her age.

Perry Smith, from whose bible the above family record is printed, attended the Litchfield Law School, settled in New Milford in the practice of his profession and was a member of the Connecticut Legislature, 1822-'24, and 1835-'36. Judge of Probate two years. In 1837 Perry Smith was elected to the United States Senate, serving until the expiration of his term in 1843. He died at New Milford, Conn. June 9, 1852.

Printed from the original record in the family bible, the record partly in Perry Smith's handwriting. The bible was published in New York, 1813.

Note:— John C. Smith, son of Perry and Ann Comstock Smith, married Mary Adams. She was born in Redding, Conn. December 16, 1824. After her marriage to Mr. Smith they resided in New Milford. Some time after the death of Hon. Perry Smith, his son, Col. John C. Smith, with his family removed to Indiana, where he died February 18, 1864.

Mrs. Smith with her three children returned to Connecticut. In 1871 they removed to Vineland, N. J. She purchased a house on East Avenue, near Park, where they resided for a number of years. The eldest daughter, Mary Isadore died March 28, 1892.

Eugenia A. the second daughter, married David E. Cowie, and resided in Brooklyn, N. Y. She returned to Vineland to die, November 22, 1901. Arthur, the only son was killed by the cars at the Railroad crossing at Norma, January 18, 1906. He was unmarried.

Mrs. Smith went from Vineland to Edgewater Park, N. J. a short time before her death, which occurred on Wednesday, October 24, 1917, in her ninety-third year. Her remains were brought to Vineland for burial in the family lot in Siloam Cemetery.
