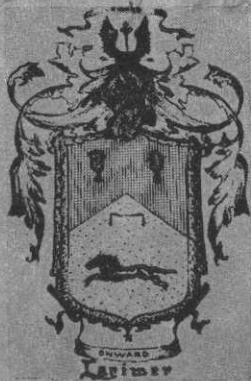

OUR LARIMER FAMILY RECORD

If there are mistakes in this compilation, please overlook them. If some families seem to be given more data than others, it is because that fuller account was not received.

The purpose of this little book is to preserve the early family record written by the late Aaron Work, of Elkhart, Indiana, born May 26, 1837, in Fairfield County, Ohio, died October 11, 1924, Middlebury, Indiana. His Mother, my Grandmother was Cynthia Hanley (Larimer) Work.

"Larimer"

The original name was French Laremier, derived from the Latin, Lorum, a th'ong. The English form Larimer, indicates the name of an ancient trade. The "Larimer" was a maker of belts, spears, stirrup irons, and all kinds of metal mountings of brass and iron including armor.

The first family record of the name is found in 1080 when a certain Durand Lorimer went from Caen, France to Scotland, doubtless with the armies of William the Conqueror. In Scotland, it is quite a common name.

OUR LARIMER FAMILY

My maternal great, great-grandfather Robert Larimer came from the North of Ireland in the year 1740. His father fitted him out with a stock of Irish linen, and with some money he left the "old country" to seek his fortune in the new.

That was before the days of steam navigation, the passage by sailing vessels was slow and often fraught with great danger. The vessel on which he embarked was wrecked and most of the crew and passengers were lost. Our great-grandfather lost everything but his life, he and a few others "Tradition records only one other man" were cast upon an island, and were picked up by a French or Spanish vessel and brought to our American shore.

The Captain of the vessel sold great-great-grandfather's time for his fare; this was contrary to the law and custom. He was sold to a farmer who lived up the river not far from Philadelphia. He was a heartless fellow and treated our G. G. grandfather like a slave. He served this man for some time, history does not record how long.

One frosty morning he was sent by the river route to the mill, started in a skiff or canoe without hat, coat or shoes. On the way he stopped at the home of a brother of his "Master" to warm. The brother had a different thought. He gave the young man a coat, hat and shoes and remarked, he thought his brother was a hog for sending a man out dressed like that on such a cold morning.

Our ancestor thought he had served long enough time and decided from that time to be on his own. He never returned, made his way to the interior of Pennsylvania "Kishocoquillas Valley" and later married Mary Gallagher or O'Gallagher, born in the North of Ireland, 1721. She died in Pa. in 1800, before any of the Larimer family moved to Ohio.

They were the parents of four children, all born in Pennsylvania.

Robert Larimer and his son Isaac, with his family, moved to Ohio about the year 1801 or 1802. Robert died soon afterward, was buried near Lancaster, Ohio, (place not known) where they lived a short time before moving to Rush Creek Township. Ebenezer, Phoebe and Grizell arrived later and settled in the woods not far from their Father's place.

"Wiseman's History of Fairfield County" records on page 352 that Robert Larimer was the first resident to die, and his daughter was the first to be married in that locality. Phoebe the daughter, married William Martin of Pennsylvania, a son of a Pioneer. They lived a number of years in Fairfield County, then settled in Carroll County, Indiana near the town of Camden. They were the parents of one son David Martin and several daughters. One daughter married a Mr. Wilson.

Before the Civil War the entire family moved to the State of Kansas.

Grizell Larimer never married, lived to be quite old and passed away at her sister Phoebe's home in Carroll County, Indiana.

On pages 36 and 49 "Scotts History of Fairfield County, Ohio" the records show that there is no record of any taxation system in Fairfield County earlier than the year 1806.

Robert, Isaac and Ebenezer Larimer are listed among the first tax payers of that year. (1806).

A part of Fairfield County was added to Perry Co. later.

.....and they resided in the Northern part of Fairfield County, Ohio, where he practiced medicine. They were parents of one child. (No record)

ISAAC LARIMER

Son of Ebenezer and Catherine Larimer lived for a brief time in Elkhart County, Indiana about the year 1840, then started west for California. (No record)

ELIZABETH (Betty) LARIMER

Daughter of Ebenezer and Catherine Larimer married Jacob Humerickhouse in Bremen, Ohio, they moved to Indiana, and lived many years in the south part of Miami County near Bennetts Switch.

They were parents of two children. A daughter, (No record) Ebenezer Humerickhouse the son, was at one time Treasurer of Miami County, Indiana.

REBECCA LARIMER

Daughter of Ebenezer and Catherine Larimer married Jesse Beery they lived in Bremen, Ohio many years. Jesse Beery was a Saddler.

PHOEBE, EMELA AND EFFIE

Daughters of Ebenezer and Catherine Larimer, are mentioned as beneficiaries in their Father Ebenezer's Will, made in 1827. (No record)

MARTHA LARIMER

Daughter of Ebenezer and Catherine Larimer married Robert Brandon who was a ~~taylor~~ *tailor* by trade, they moved west and settled in Peru, Indiana, in year 1840. Later in life he became a contractor and was quite prosperous. They were parents of two children.

ISAAC LARIMER SR. B-1771 - D-1823

Son of Robert Larimer and Mary Gallagher Larimer was born in Kishocoquillis Valley, Pa., married Elizabeth Woods born in Maryland, B - 1773, D - 1851, in Fairfield County, Ohio. They moved west to near Lancaster, Ohio, in 1801-02 for a short time, later they settled in Rush Creek Twp., on Sec. 26 Twp. 16R.17. Patent Title came from U. S. Government through the General Land Office at Chillicothe, Ohio, Capital of Ohio State at that time.

It was said that Elizabeth Woods Larimer returned on horseback to her old Maryland home from Pa., Dec. 7, 1799, to visit her father and witnessed several funeral ceremonies for George Washington enroute.

History does not record much about Isaac Larimer Sr., but from our family papers and records we learn that he was a large man over 6 ft. in height and of remarkable strength, it was said he was the most powerful man in that whole region, he was a leader, and a christian man of some prominence in the community in that early day. They were among the first to settle in Rush Creek Twp., and they were given the credit of naming some of the hills and streams "Rush Creek" because the creek water rushed into the valley, often overflowing the plateau upon which the town of Breman stands.

Other streams, "Bear Run" and "Turkey Run". One of the hills "Chestnut Ridge" because Chestnuts were plentiful. A settlement "Scotch Ridge" because Scotch Irish people settled there.

Isaac Larimer was of the earnest Covenantor Presbyterian Stock, and was active in the First Rush-Creek Presbyterian Church which was organized in 1806, and in 1807 a two story hewed log house was built in a place known as "Jockey Hollow" on Joseph S. Shaw's farm two miles south of West Rushville where they worshiped until 1830.

(Page 245 Wiseman's History Fairfield Co., Ohio)

In the Centennial Book of the Presbyterian Church of Lancaster, Ohio, published in 1905, it stated that Isaac Larimer and John McCormick of the Rush-Creek Congregation were unanimously chosen to sign the Call, with those chosen by the Hock Hocking Congregation, (First Presbyterian Church of Lancaster, Ohio.)

The Call was sent to Rev. John Wright, who accepted it Oct. 15-1805 and he entered his duties Nov. 14-1805, as their first minister. Rev. Wright served the two Congregations until the year 1832, when he devoted his entire time with the Lancaster Church.

Isaac Larimer Sr., passed away in the year 1823. This First Rush-Creek Church, where Isaac Larimer Sr., and several of the Larimer families worshiped was abandoned in the year 1830. Some of the Society moved to the new brick church which was built on the site of the present cemetery in West Rushville, Ohio.

William Larimer, William Trimble and David Y. Davis were Elders. Some of the Rush-Creek Society united with the Old Bethel Church, built in the year 1828, organized 1832. John Larimer, Jacob Moyer, Amos Davis were first Elders, Rev. Francis Bartlett was first Pastor. In the year 1852 Rev. Milligan was Pastor. Isaac Larimer, Jr., John Sherwood, Aaron Work, Geo. McCandlish, and James Black were Elders. (Scotts H.134) Our record has the name of Wright Larimer as an elder.

Harvey Scott's History of Fairfield County, Ohio, (Page 96) has recorded his (Scott's) inability to write more about the early settlers of Rush-Creek Twp., because he did not have the correct information.

ISAAC LARIMER SR.

Isaac Larimer, Sr., and his son Robert Larimer, answered the call for war time troops and enlisted in the year 1812, and when General Hull surrendered his division to the British General Brock at Detroit, Isaac and his son were in that part of the army and were paroled. Isaac was an Ensign at the time of his capture, and he was the only officer in the regiment who was allowed to retain his side arms. When the British Officer demanded his sword and pistol he raised his sword in the air and said "When I took this sword I resolved to free my country or die in the attempt". The officer smiled and passed.

Isaac Larimer Sr.'s Grandson John Wright Larimer of Greenville, Ohio, became the owner of that sword, which was a souvenir to him of priceless worth. It was later given and is now in possession of Great-Grandson John Larimer Wilson of Columbus, Ohio.

Isaac Larimer Sr., did not re-enter the army nor was he exchanged. His son Robert disregarded his parole, did re-enlist in the second company from Lancaster, Ohio and served until the close of the war. He was in several battles, one the battle of Ox Bow Cannard, he was acting drummer when ordered to retreat, he swung his drum by the straps over his shoulder, the straps broke or were cut by bullets and the drum was captured by the British. History records that the drummer was shot, but this was an error because Robert told his story upon his return. It was also recorded that the drum was recovered by our American Army.

Robert Larimer lived many years in Indiana and is buried in Eldredge Cemetery near Middlebury, Indiana.

Isaac Larimer died in the year 1823. He owned approximately 500 acres of land in Fairfield County, Ohio, 160 acres in Seneca County, Ohio and 53 acres in Perry County, Ohio.

The traditional story is that he was buried on his own farm and that one Samuel Ray is buried at his side, the location of these two graves is lost, to date 1958 no one knows where they are buried.

We believe Isaac Larimer is one of Fairfield County, Ohio's forgotten men.

His service commenced April 13, 1812 and expired April 15, 1813. He served one month and 12 days as an Orderly Sergeant and was elected an Ensign May 28, 1812.

ISAAC LARIMER SR.

"Wiseman's History of Fairfield County, Ohio, Page 352." records that Isaac Larimer Sr. was an "Ensign" in the first company which marched from Lancaster, Ohio to Detroit in the war of 1812.

The title of "Ensign" was used in the army in that day. It is now used to show the rank of an Officer in the Navy.

Isaac was a son of Robert and Mary (Gallagher) Larimer born in Pa. 1771, died in Fairfield Co., Ohio, 1823, married Elizabeth Woods in Pa. who was born 1773, D - 1851. They settled in Rush Creek Twp., Ohio 1801 or 1802, not far from Bremen, they were among the first to settle there.

Afterward he re-enlisted, disregarding his parole, he was in several battles. Married Mary Lamastes, parents of (8) children all born in Fairfield County, Ohio.

In the year 1840 they settled in Elkhart County, Indiana, Middlebury Twp. later in 1847 to LaGrange County, near East Lake. Robert Larimer died at the age of 56 and was buried in Eldridge Cemetery near Middlebury, Indiana.

JAMES LARIMER

Son of Robert Larimer and Mary (Lamastes) Larimer returned to Ohio in 1843 and married Miss Cochran, of Perry County, she passed away soon afterward. They were the parents of one son, who was reared by the Cochran family in Ohio. He grew to manhood and lost his life in the Civil War, 1861 - 1865.

James Larimer returned to Indiana and married Elizabeth Herrald, they lived in LaPorte, Indiana. They were parents of several sons, one son Daniel Larimer lived in Goshen, Indiana.

Elizabeth (Herrald) Larimer died in LaPorte, Indiana.

James Larimer married the third time, moved to Sioux City, Iowa, where he passed away several years ago.

PHOEBE McKIBBIN

Daughter of Alexander McKibbin and Harriet (Larimer) McKibbin married Rev. Baruch Herrold, they live in Goshen, Indiana, part of the family moved to the west later. (No record)

CYNTHIA McKIBBIN

Daughter of Alexander McKibbin and Harriet (Larimer) McKibbin married Christian Garber they settled in LaJunta, Colorado, many years ago. (No record)

MARY McKIBBIN

Daughter of Alexander McKibbin and Harriet (Larimer) McKibbin, married Charles Showalter, he followed the trade of a blacksmith, they were parents of two children, they reside in Goshen, Indiana. (No other record)

ROBERT BRADFORD LARIMER AND MOSES LARIMER

Sons of Robert Larimer and Mary (Lamastes) Larimer, both passed their remaining years at the home of their brother-in-law's (Alex McKibbin) in Elkhart County, Indiana, one at the age of 28 years, the other much older, they were never married.

PHOEBE LARIMER

Daughter of Robert Larimer and Mary (Lamastes) Larimer married John Eldridge, 1842, they lived many years on a farm near Forest Grove in Middlebury Twp., Indiana. Phoebe passed away in the year 1867, John Eldridge at the age of 80. They are buried in Eldridge Cemetery near Forest Grove, Indiana. They were parents of six children.

Daughter of Phoebe (Larimer) Eldridge and John Eldridge, married William Poyser, who lost his life by a falling tree, they were parents of several children. After a few years Emma Eldridge married again and resided in Cassapolis, Mich. (No record)

WILLIAM ELDRIDGE

Son of Phoebe (Larimer) Eldridge and John Eldridge married, lived for years at Constantine, Mich. (No record)

CYNTHIA LARIMER

Daughter of Robert Larimer and Mary (Lamastes) Larimer married Daniel Elliott in the year 1857. Cynthia Larimer born 1836, spent most of her life in or near Middlebury, Indiana. Died 1884 or 1885. They were parents of two sons. Charles Elliott Bert Elliott

CHARLES ELLIOTT

Son of Cynthia (Larimer) Elliott and Daniel Elliott, was Post Master at Middlebury, Indiana, for a number of years. (No record)

BERT ELLIOTT

Son of Cynthia (Larimer) Elliott and Daniel Elliott, lived in Elkhart, Indiana, for many years, he served as a City Councilman at one time. (No record)

JOHN LARIMER

Second son of Isaac Larimer Sr., and Elizabeth (Woods) Larimer was born in Pa., before the family emigrated to Ohio. In the year 1813 being in his teens, he served as a 90 days man, from Ohio, in the war that was then on with England. In the year 1818 he married Miss Rachael Smith, and lived near the old homestead until 1835 they moved west to Elkhart County, Indiana, and settled on new land in Middlebury Twp. They were parents of nine children.

Rachel (Smith) Larimer, wife of John Larimer died in the year 1838, later John Larimer returned to Ohio and married Mrs. Nancy Smith a widow of his first wife's cousin who lived on a farm near Logan, Ohio. He returned to Indiana with his second bride and her three children Ellen, John, and Green Smith.

John Larimer died in the year 1843, with an infection of his throat caused by a deer bone splinter which lodged there.

Soon after his death, Nancy (Smith) Larimer returned to the near Logan, Ohio farm where she lived until her death about the year 1859. Ellen Smith her daughter married Isaac Everitt and they lived on a farm not far from his father's farm.

BRICE LARIMER

Son of John Larimer and Rachel (Smith) Larimer, at the age of 28 married Lucy Bentley they lived most of their lives in Millersburg, Indiana where they settled in the year 1858. He became station master of the N. Y. Central Railroad, a position he held for more than 40 years. He passed away 1907, and his wife in 1898.

JAMES LARIMER

Son of Isaac Larimer, Sr., and Elizabeth Woods Larimer, married a Miss Ascenath Cornwell in Fairfield Co., Ohio. In the year 1835 they moved west with his brother Moses to Elkhart Co., Indiana. Part of the land they settled upon he sold to his brother-in-law, Abel Everitt Work in the year 1842. James was a large strong man and was considered one of the best "Axe" men in that county, he was called the "Comer man" in raising a log building, he would also enter into wood chopping contests to see who could reach the heart of a tree first. In other words James Larimer was an expert rail splitter, all of the fences were made of split rails in that day. James lost his life in an accident in the year 1846, while returning home one December night from Middlebury, Indiana the ground was frozen, the horse he was riding stumbled and fell, he was thrown striking his head, he died instantly. The accident occurred near the Leander Foster farm south of Middlebury Indiana. They were the parents of five children.

AMOS LARIMER

Son of James and Ascenath (Cornwell) Larimer, B-1838, married and lived in Wisconsin, later moved with his family across the plains to the west coast, San Francisco. A traditional story recounts that Amos and a friend built a boat, after loading on supplies, the two families went aboard and they started on the Pacific Ocean headed north for the State of Oregon, they never arrived at their destination, no doubt all were lost. Amos had previously made a remark, "that a man born to drown would never be struck with lightening" that was his reply when questioned about the propriety of taking shelter, with his plow and team under a large tree for the duration of a lightening and thunder storm, his prediction no doubt came true.

ANDERSON WRIGHT LARIMER

Son of James and Ascenath (Cornwell) Larimer, made the trip to California with his brother Amos he married in California. They were parents of two sons, one became a wholesale merchant, the other a rail road man. Anderson W. Larimer had high standing in the Order of Odd Fellows. Some of his family still reside in San Francisco.

JAMES ELMER LARIMER

Son of James and Ascenath (Cornwell) Larimer, plied his trade as a blacksmith at Goshen, Indiana. At the beginning of the Civil War he enlisted at Lancaster, Ohio, the first man to enlist in Ohio's 1st. Reg. of Volunteer Infantry. He was in the first battle of Bull Run, which was fought five days after his enlistment expired.

Re-enlisting in Company A., 17th Regiment Ohio Volunteers he was commissioned a Lieutenant, commanding four Companies of the 23rd., Missouri Volunteers. He marched eight thousand miles in the service. After the war was married to Miss Rhoda Amelia Ward, August 15, 1865, settled in Lawrenceburg, Ind. Appointed Revenue Officer by President U. S. Grant in year 1869. In the year 1878 to 1893, he was owner and editor of the Lawrenceburg Indiana Press. They were parents of one daughter Laura Larimer, who became Mrs. B. R. Smith, Park Ridge, Ill., D. 1-1923.

JOHN C. LARIMER

Son of James and Ascenath (Cornwell) Larimer, was also a soldier in the Civil War, he was wounded in the Battle of Pittsburgh Landing, after his recovery, he entered the army again. He was taken sick and died in a hospital in Boliver, Tenn.

ASCENATH (Cornwell) LARIMER

Widow of James Larimer and mother of the above family, sold her home near Middlebury, Indiana, 1851, and with Nancy Elizabeth, the youngest and only daughter made a visit with relatives in Rome, N. Y., returning to Athens, Ohio, later she left Nancy Elizabeth at the home of her Aunt and Uncle Abel Everitt and Elizabeth Larimer Everitt, before starting across the continent with her two brothers John and Goldsmith Cornwell to pan for Gold in California. Ascenath was to be the housekeeper, they were to share and share alike, the venture failed, no great amount of Gold was found, the Cornwell brothers returned to Ohio, Ascenath stayed on and began teaching and nursing in San Francisco, she being well educated for that day, after accumulating some property, she sent for her daughter, Nancy Elizabeth, who made the trip to the west coast by the way of N. Y. and Isthmas of Panama, with a trusted and well known friend of the family.

NANCY ELIZABETH LARIMER

Daughter of James and Ascenath (Cornwell) Larimer was educated in California, married a Mr. Mosse, who later died leaving her a widow, with two daughters, Elfie and Alice Mosse.

Ascenath Larimer, mother of Nancy Elizabeth (Larimer) Mosse moved from San Francisco and acquired a home in a small community at that time, now the city of Santa Monica, where she spent her remaining years, passing away 3-2-1897. Age 87 years. Nancy Elizabeth (Larimer) Mosse married second time Mr. Gaddy who lived but a short time.

It was my pleasure to visit Mrs. Gaddy in that Santa Monica home in the year 1911, she was a most interesting person, and related the fact that the First Public Library in Santa Monica was started in her home and that she acted as the first Librarian. She passed away Sept. 2, 1929.

ELFIE MOSSE

Daughter of Nancy Elizabeth Larimer Gaddy, became the Librarian and served for several years. She passed away about the year 1932.

ALICE MOSSE

Daughter of Nancy Elizabeth Larimer Gaddy, was employed in the Court House in Los Angeles, married Dr. Lindsey, a dentist, they were parents of one son Metzger M. (MEL) Lindsey who became a teacher in Los Angeles, Calif.

ISAAC LARIMER JR.

Son of Isaac Larimer Sr., and Elizabeth Woods Larimer was born in Fairfield County, Ohio, near Bremen, in the year 1808. He was a man of great decision of character, strong intellectually and vigorous thought, having a fine command of language he was forceful and ready public speaker in an impromptu way. His fountain of knowledge was not fed so much by scholastic training as by self application and careful study of the best literature and of the fine problems of the day. He had clearly defined political convictions, he was a Democrat and a strong advocate of abolition, though at variance with the majority of his party in the crucial period culminating in the war of the Rebellion. He was held in high estimation by the people of Perry, Hocking and Fairfield Counties which he represented with efficiency in the Ohio State Legislature in the years 1848-1849. "Wiseman's History Of Fairfield Co., Page 352" He was a strong advocate for the cause of Abolition during the Lincoln-Douglas Campaign and was a great admirer of the martyr President.

In religion his faith was that of The Presbyterian Church and he was an officer in the church at the time of his death in the year 1874, Greenville, Ohio. Isaac Larimer Jr., arrived in Darke County, Ohio in 1865, purchased land in Greenville Twp., where he made his home, married Miss Margaret Ray in 1834. She was an Ohio native, born 1813, died 1873. They were parents of six children.

Like his father he was a man of decided convictions and manifested much interest in public affairs. Fraternally he was a charter member of I. O. O. F. Lodge No. 748 for over 50 years. also Past Commander of Greenville Post G.A.R. He was a Republican and cast his first vote for Abraham Lincoln, he was a delegate to many County and State conventions and was familiarly known by his many friends as "Uncle John"

He held to his early teachings of the Presbyterian Doctrine, all of his family were members of the Reformed Church.

This happened before rail roads, telegraph, or mail service. Aunt Sarah kept the family together until they all reached the adult age, and she had every reason to be proud of her family. She was near 70 when she passed away.

CYNTHIA HANLEY LARIMER

Daughter of Isaac Larimer Sr., and Elizabeth (Woods) Larimer married 1863 Abel Everitt Work, his father was Aaron Work who married Milocent Everitt, their first child they named Abel Everitt after her Father Abel Everitt, thence the name Abel Everitt Work as above. The name (Hanley) was the name of a family and friends of Isaac and Elizabeth (Woods) Larimer in their young days. Cynthia Hanley Larimer was the youngest of the family. Abel Everitt Work was a blacksmith, had a shop on the N.E. corner of the crossroad 2½ miles east of Bremen and one mile north of Bethel Presbyterian Church. In year 1841 he made a trip to Elkhart Co., Indiana and purchased land from James Larimer, his brother-in-law. John, James and Robert Larimer had settled in Elkhart Co., year 1835. The big move to Indiana began Oct., 1842. John and Robert Larimer returned to Ohio to assist the movers, 15 souls started from the old Work home on Marietta Rd. Four dropped off at different points enroute, 11 making the entire trip. In the party besides the 5 of the the Work family, were John Larimer, Aunt Nancy (Smith) Larimer her sister, Mrs. Jane Duvall and her infant babe, who was returning home after a visit in Logan, Ohio, Aunt Nancy (Smith) Larimer, two sons John and Green Smith, Robert Larimer, Mrs. Jean Martin, who was a widow of Ellison Martin, Elizabeth Meteer, a cousin, and James Meteer Work, grandfather of Alice Work. After traveling for 30 days they arrived at John Larimer's Indiana home, November 17, 1842. The children left at home, Brice and his sister Eleanor and step-sister, Ellen Smith, had gone to clean up the vacant house and make it ready for the tired travelers to move into.

Abel Everitt Work and Cynthia (Larimer) Work lived in that home 4 years. They were parents of a family of eight sons.

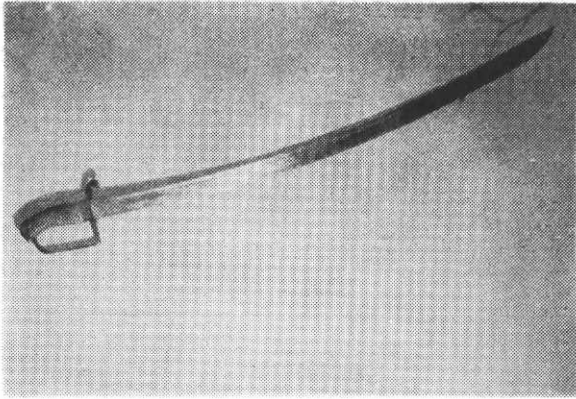
