
When Paul Hendee first contacted me he identified his lineage to Zebulon Hendee who was married to Barbary Fullerton in Dutchess County, NY. According to the best information I had at the time, I could not see a connection to our Family Tree even though we both had a Zebulon Hendee. Paul's Zebulon was born in 1766, mine in 1719.

In addition, I found on Ancestry that Paul's Zebulon was born in Scotland:



Since it didn't seem likely that no one in our line could have fathered him in Scotland, I surmised that Paul and I were from different Hendee lines.

Having a little time on my hands, I recently delved into this matter further. Knowing that OneWorldTree information might be based on erroneous or unverified information from other Ancestry members, I searched again and found this record showing his birthplace to be Rumbout, Bute, Scotland:



But Interesting enough, I discovered that there is <u>no</u> Rumbout in Bute County, Scotland but there is a Rumbout in Dutchess County, New York where One Tree shows him being married!

That is also where Paul Hendee belived he was born:





Further, Paul's Pedigree Chart shows his Zebulon's grandparents parents to be Jonathan Hendee (1694-1775) and Martha Millington.


Pedigree Chart




Even though our Zebulon was also born in 1719, I show his parents to be Jonathan Hendee (1694-1775) and Rachel Knight (1691-1774), not Jonathan Handee and Martha Millington.:



I thought it quite a coincidence that our Jonathan Hendee and his Jonathan Handee lived at exactly the same time, so I looked further and found this:



This would seem to confirm that his Zebulon was not our Zebulon. But wait..... I came across this on Ancestry showing that our Zebulon (son of Jonathan and Rachel) was in fact married in Rumbout (Poughkeepsie), Dutchess County, NY to Elizabeth Lewis, his Zebulon's wife!




So, it certainly appears that his Zebulon and our Zebulon could be the same <u>if</u> they have the same parents. I tried to order the original document to verify Zebulon's parents, but discovered that Vital Check can only go back to 1800.

The confusion stems from the fact that Jonathan Hendee (1694-1775) was married twice, first to Rachel Knight (1691-1774) then to Martha Millington (1706-1791). On pg. 319 of the Book of Biographies: This Volume Contains Biographical Sketches of Leading Citizens of Rutland County, Vermont, we see the following as evidence that Zebulon's parents were Jonathan and Rachel:

Jonathan Hendee was also twice married. His first wife died and left him David, Barzillai, Asa, and Hannah. A later marriage with Martha Millington resulted in the following five children: Jonathan, Richard, Caleb, Richard, and Martha. Jonathan Hendee

Not withstanding the fact that the same document asserts that Richard Hendee (1) "...was a descendant of a French Protestant family who for religious reasons were expelled from Normandy, and settled in England." (a piece of family folkyore that has not yet to my satisfaction been verified) it would appear that we are, in fact related to Paul Hendee.

It would appear tha Paul erroreously linked his branch to Martha Millington, not Rachael Knight and that makes him our <u>6x half cousin once removed!</u>
