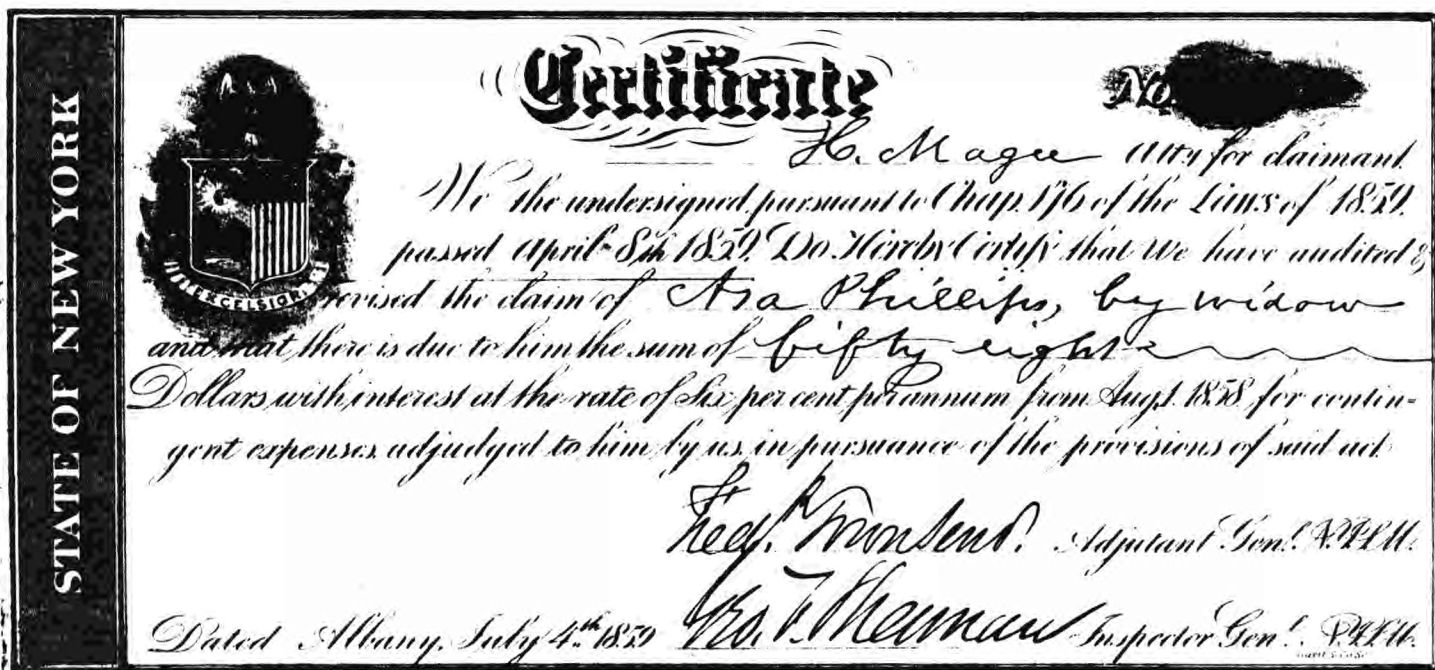
Our earliest known Phillips ancestor is Asa Phillips who, according to The Historical Gazeteer of Steuben County, New York, by Millard F. Roberts, Syracuse, New York, 1891 "came on foot from the state of Vermont in 1802 and settled in the now town of Avoca about three-quarters of a mile south of Wallace Station. It is said that he, in company with John B. Calkins, built the first saw mill in the town, Mr. Phillips building the race alone. He also cleared his farm. In 1842 Mr. Phillips moved to Hornellsville, now Fremont, and settled on the farm now owned by his son Asa."

Family records available to this compiler do not indicate where in Vermont Asa came from. For some reason Windham County was investigated as a strong possibility. In the 1800 census for that county an Asa Phillips is the only Phillips listed as a "Head of Family" in the town of Stratton. He is listed as being the head of the following family: 2 males under 10, 1 male 10 to 16, male head of family 26 to 45, 1 female under 10, and 1 female 26 to 45. Whether or not these Phillips are related to our Asa Phillips remains a mystery at this time.

Our Asa Phillips served as a corporal in the War of 1812 in Captain Jonas Cleland's Company, Colonel Dobbin's Regiment of the New York State Militia. He served from July 1, 1812, to October 18, 1812, at Lewiston, New York. He re-enlisted in the Militia for short terms again and again. He was discharged on September 9, 1813, only to re-enlist the following day as a sergeant in Captain Hurd's Company at Bath or Cohocton. He received his final discharge on December 1, 1813. His widow Tamma applied for bounty land due to veterans and their widows on May 17, 1851, and was granted eighty acres of "glade" (apparently partly improved land) which brought her acreage to 129. They had moved to this farm near Fremont in 1842. She stayed on this land and reared the rest of her children. After her death in 1876, the property belonged to her son Asa, Jr.

In 1823 Asa Phillips became an Ensign in a separate Battalion of Infantry attached to the First Brigade of Infantry of the State of New York. A copy of his commission signed by Governor DeWitt Clinton is included in this Forward. Also included is a copy of a certificate dated 1859 revising the claim of Asa's widow for money due to her as a result of his military involvements.



The information on the following pages is based on original research which has been conducted over a period of several years and compiled from many sources. To help the reader understand the numbering system used throughout the history, the following explanation is offered:

Identification Number	Generation Number

The number which appears before the family member's name is his identification number and will appear whenever he/she is mentioned. The generation number will be elevated following the family member's name and will show to which generation each member belongs. Asa

Phillips comprises the first generation since he, to date, is our earliest known Phillips ancestor.

Although every effort has been made to make this history as complete and as accurate as time and resources permit, there are certain to be errors and omissions. Hopefully, after reading this family story, family members will have gained knowledge of some of their "roots." L. G. Pine in his book TRACE YOUR ANCESTORS states:

Remember, too, that it is a shame to be ignorant of one's forebears. People will often insist on a pedigree for their dogs or horses while being indifferent about their own. This is the clearest folly. Let us know the stock from whence we came. We shall then know something of ourselves.

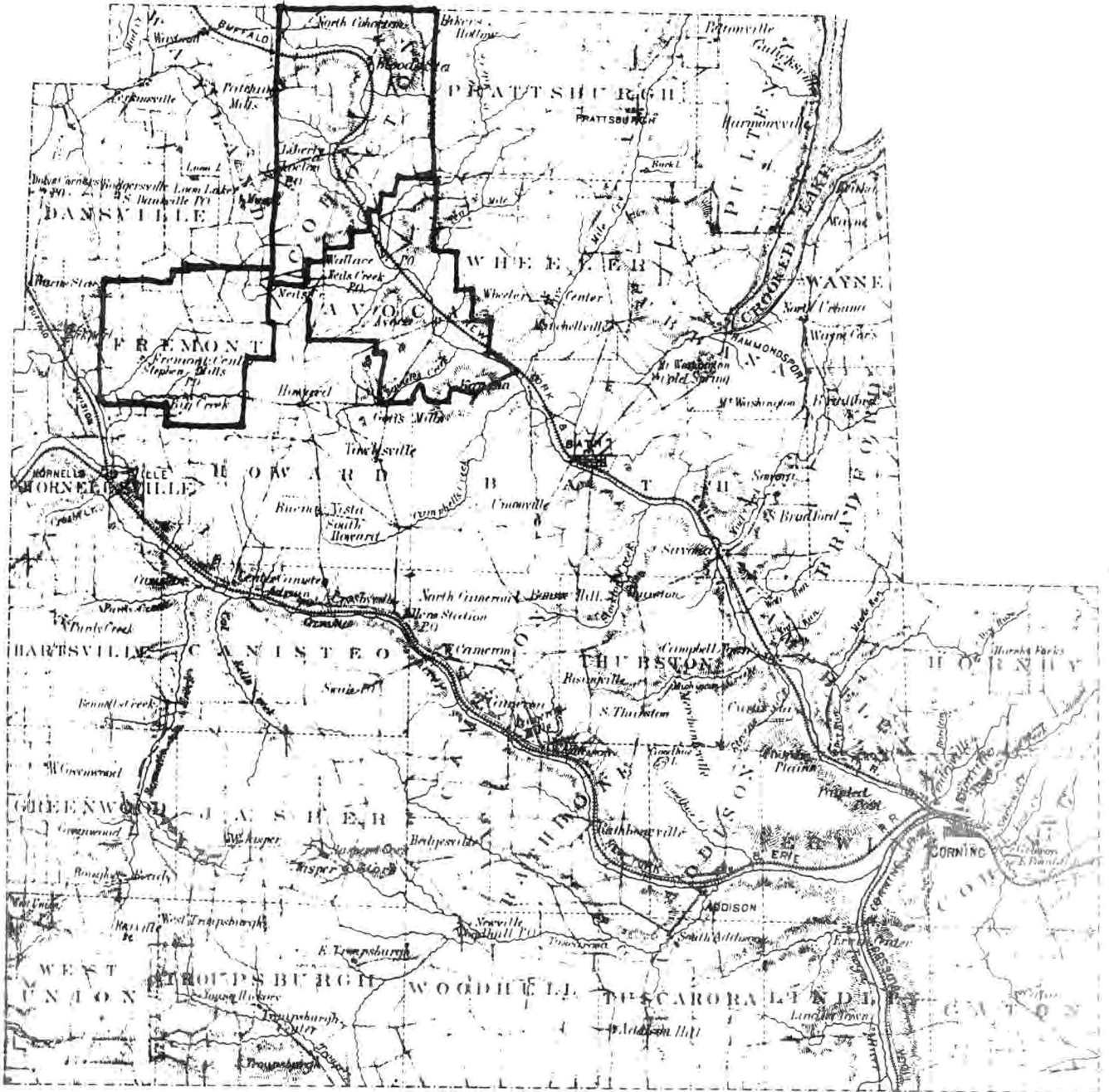

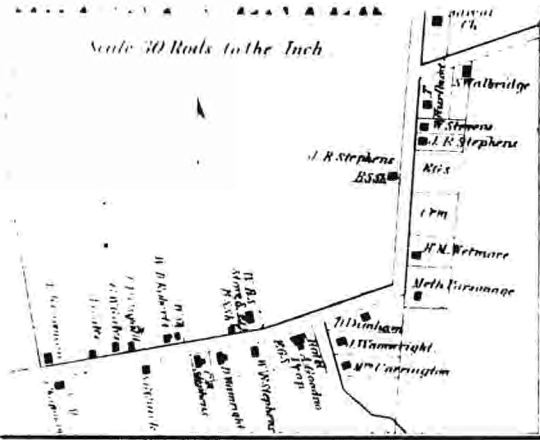


Towns of Avoca, Fremont, and Cohocton are outlined.

The following comments were taken from A HISTORY OF STEUBEN COUNTY, NEW YORK, AND ITS PEOPLE by Irvin W. Near, Volume 11, 1911, page 603:

James Ross Babcock came to Steuben County with his father when he was eighteen years of age. The latter settled on the Cohocton River and later moved to Buffalo (New York), when it was only a village. James R. Babcock lived for some time in Coshocton, Ohio, but returned to Steuben County and engaged in business as a contractor and builder, as well as a farmer. He erected a large number of buildings in the county and lived on his farm in Fremont until he was eighty years of age. When he located on his farm there was but two acres of land cleared and he continued the work of clearing and improving it. He owned one hundred and thirty acres. He and his wife Ruth Phillips were among the early settlers of Steuben County and were very well known.

Memo written by Ethel Clarissa Russell Morris in March, 1982, regarding her grandmother:

Grandmother, Maranda White Phillips House, was a woman worthy of a generation's effort to remember her. I think I am the only person living who remembers her. She was a great part of my early life - a loving, healing presence - often as I was with her much of the time. She made all of my clothing, having been taught to do tailoring; even her coats were perfection. Her food was always better than any other, and as for stories, no one could begin to touch them. How people lived and Indians were made vivid and I never tired of "one more". To the public she was sedate, kindly and the ideal woman of the times. These days would be beyond her wildest imagination. Grandmother made frequent visits to Michigan and was always interested in Marcus' family. She tried to have me correspond with Cora, who was about my age. I am afraid I wasn't too good natured about it. Her letters were more interesting to her than to me. Uncle Marcus came to visit his mother and I liked him. Never quite understood because I saw so much of my other relatives. The larger picture is a good likeness as I remember Maranda, mother of Marcus. The snapshot is with her husband and daughter Cora. Note the picture was taken in Wisconsin. Her brother, John, was in the grocery business in Winneconne. I recall a prolonged visit she made to him and his family.

Asa was a farmer on his mother's land. He built a large house on the homestead which still stands (1988) on Reservoir Road near Stephens Mills in Steuben County. Asa and Catherine separated in the 1870's/1880's and she and the children moved to Hornell in Steuben County. Asa remained on the farm until he died. The following comments regarding Catherine's family were taken from the HISTORICAL GAZETEER OF STEUBEN COUNTY, NEW YORK, Millard F. Roberts, Syracuse, New York, 1891:

Adam Conderman, father of Cornelius and grandfather of Catherine, came with his family to the now town of Fremont in 1818, and there took up 400 acres of land, intending a farm of 100 acres for each of his four sons. He located on what is now known as Dutch Street about one mile west of Job's Corners. The family came in a covered wagon, which was their only shelter at night, and Mr. Conderman drove a few cows, making the journey by way of Utica, Geneva, and Penn Yan, to Bath and thence by way of Kennedyville to Goff's Mills, to Howard Flats.

Cynthia Phillips Palmer corresponded with her niece (26) Maryett Babcock Kelly after she left Steuben County for Iowa. Two of her letters have survived and are included here to give a "flavor of the times":

Anamosa, November 21, 1866

Dear Niece,

I will try once more to write you. I wrote one letter but it was so poor that I could not send it. This may not be much better but I will try and send it. Well what shall I write first, so much to write, as usually, my famley are all well but myself. I have bin sick a bed part of the time since the first of Sept. and just able to mope about the rest of the time. I have got so weak and bade that I have bin obliged for several weeks to give up house work entirely, the Doct says that it is weakness that ales me, my wright side pains me so much all the time and such a weakness that I can not stand on my feet but a few minits at a time. I am alone a good deal, have a girl working for her board and goes to scool, some times the flowers are without sweeping for several days. It is hard to sit and see so much that wants to be don. It is very hard geting good help here, this girl is agoing to work for me all winter after this term is out, I have worked too hard this fall I expect what brought me down but I could not avoid it. I get home sick some time but get over it. Henry says I can go home eny time that I want to he says. I would not be contented to stay long enough to have it do me eny good to go and he does not think I could endure the jorney at present, I am taking no medician but using watter. I wish you could come and see me I could tell you so much that I want to tell you. I have not heer from home in some time and but a little news then. But Hariett's leaving home was news that took me by supprise yes astonished me. I think it was very strange that I never had heard that their was such a man in the world until she was married to him. I do feel that their was or is not much confidence or trust put in me or I could hear of some thing before every body knew all about it but Mother always said let those wear gold that wone it so with me I (rest of letter missing).

Anamosa, July 5, 1874

Dear Neice,

I was so glad to get your letter, I have thought for some time that you was sick because you did not write, when you do not write I have to go without letters. I appreciate your letters ever so so much I can assure you. I do wish I could come and see you often but my ambition is gon it seems like a great taske to go so far from home again. I have worked very hard to go home so many times but now I canot work but very little. I have don the least work since last January that I ever did when I was so to be about, some days I can sew nearley all day and perhaps the next day I canot do any thing, the trouble is in my sholders and spine the effects of the Fever I hade year ago last january. I worked to hard last year befor I got strong I kept at work as long as I could and now I ought not to sew but feel as though I must do some thing to help a little. I am now taking Electric Baths 3 a week at \$1.50 each time. I think it is agoing to help me but have not taken them long enough to tell yet, the first week it maid me worse every time our folks all would say when I got home how bade you look. I had a home sick fit a few weeks ago and almost thought at one time I would go insted of paing out the money for doctering but I maide up my mind if you were sick and could not write and their was no one els to write me a letter they did not care much for me and I got all over wanting come and I do not think I shall come very soon again. I have paide out a good deal of money to come and visit my frinds and now if my Brothers and Sisters do not think enough of me to write to me occasonly it is all wright. We are having very hot weather here now. I expect Sale Rogger here this week to visit 2 weeks. I went to see her in April staid one week. Cora is having her long vacation now she is making her own under clothes alone this year and she maid a dark calico dress in April don it niceley. Cora is such a help and she is so good to do all that she can, we did not eny whear the 4 except to ride to the river trough the woods at 4 pm took the Milner that works for Henry a Mrs. Merrill from Chicago a widow and the girl that does the house work that is our family now. All the spring we had one more girl in the store. I get tired having so manny around although they are all real nice and pleasant. Mrs. Merrill is very much of a lady, how I do wish I could see you. I have so much to tell you and I want to see the little folks particular the baby. I pity you Dear girl you have to be sick and have so much sickness but we hope and trust all is for the best for you and we and all of us give love to Grandmother (write often as you can and I will waite for your letters in love you are so good to write to your unworthy Aunt, love to all

your as ever your affectionate
Aunt Cynthia

It is very hard work for me to write. It makes my spine ache so so you will excuse poor writing. I maid a mistake. I thought I had wrote on this page but number them so you can reade it I guess. I have to stop every few minits and hold my neck and head they ache so bade I comenced this yesterday and so thought to finish it this morning before breakfast. I hope to be better this week than I was last but I do not know as I shall be the least effor to work give me so much pain in neck I can not hardly tell what I am about -
No more this time

Cynthia's monument in Riverside Cemetery was still in excellent condition in 1978. It was described by her daughter Cora in a letter to her cousin (26) Maryett Babcock Kelly. The letter is dated 27 October 1880, and reads as follows:

Center Point, Linn County, Iowa

Dear Cousin Maryett,

Your welcome letter received last week was so glad to hear from you. When I sent the paper I thought I would surely write before this time but my time has been so much occupied that I have neglected most all of my letter writing. Pa and myself are quite well or at least he was when I left him Monday morning. You will remember that Miss Sale Rogers is the Post Mistress at this place and I am visiting her this week. She is just as jolly as ever, she has had the Post Office for six years so you can judge by that how well she is liked here. Mother Austin and myself have been to Anamosa and spent a week with Grandmother and my friends since my husband died. Grandma is pretty well for her of course she is lame all the time but she is able to get around enough to do her own work. I drove up our horse and carriage from Hale and while I was there I took Grandma out in the country about five miles and we spent the day with friends of ours and she enjoyed it very much, she has not done such a thing for years. I expect to be with Pa most of the time this winter. We have rented the lower part of our house and we are going to fit up the upper part of the house for ourselves and board out, the house is quite good size so our rooms are quite pleasant, the front room we have for our parlor and sitting room. They are painting the rooms this week so I thought I would come away for I could not settle them until that was done. It seems as though now that I had no one to do for but Pa and he for me and so we will appreciate being together. Of course I am very lonely at times wherever I am but my Father who art in Heaven has walked by my side through my past trials and afflictions and I will have Him to comfort and support me unto the end. Oh, Cousin, this trouble would have crushed me had I not put my trust in our blessed Redeemer before the trials of this life came with such blows. Life must be a blank to those who do not put their faith in the one who rulest all things. I thank you so much for writing so promptly after Mother's death and my Husband's death. Pa and I both appreciate your letters very much. My Husband was taken sick so soon after we received your letter that I did not get time to answer it and my time was completely taken up taking care of him that I did not write to any one hardly and I thought Pa had written you. I wrote to Aunt Mary Wycoff and sent her a paper with Mother's death in and she has never answered it. Tell Libbie I should like to hear from her very much. Give my love and Father's to all the inquiring relatives, yourself and household please include.

P.S.

Pa has gone into the hardware business in Cedar Rapids. The Saturday that I was in Anamosa Pa came down and set up a beautiful monument on Mother's grave. He bought it in Chicago. The design was rustic, a oak tree broaken off about 8 feet above the roots. There is an ivy running up over the tree, the leaves are carved perfect and the bark on the tree is carved perfectly natural. Every one who sees it thinks it is beautiful. I wish you could seeit. Mother was so fond of everything rustic that I like it very much on that account. Sale Rogers sends love to you. Good Bye for this time.

The following letter was written by Adelia to her cousin (26) Maryett and John Kelly on November 3, 1889:

Dear Cousins John and Maryett,

It is a beautiful moonlight night and I will try and visit a little with you. I have not felt like writing since I got home for the greater part of the time the weather has just been horrible. When I got home I found it very dry here, it kept getting dryer and smokier until for several weeks past we only got an occasional glimpse of the sun, so smoky at times we could not see to the barn and the smoke so we could see and smell it in the house, every day we pumped both wells dry for the stock, we had once in a while a shower but no general rain until two days ago, we had one that lasted long enough to clear the air and every body is thankful. Minnie is in Midland teaching, she writes she gets pretty tired boarding herself. Our district school begins tomorrow. Mary will go, she is a large girl a little taller than I am, she will be fourteen years in ten days. Loren is well now, he was not well while I was away and was quite sick after I got home again. Henry has been quite well for him the past summer, last night he was sick with the rheumatism but is better today. The fires did no damage to us, but not far from us in the pine country they lost in some places farm buildings, fences, etc. Our crops were not very good, had a terrible wind storm here before I came home which laid his oats flat, they had to mow them, he had 425 bushels of oats, 70 some thing of millett and about 25 of buckwheat, about 75 bushels of sugar beets, and about 75 of potatoes, but there is no price for anything, oats are twenty cents per bushel, potatoes twenty-five if one can find a buyer, cream has been sixteen cents along back, eggs are twenty cents. Henry butchered a beef and peddled it out from four to six cents a lb., he is

going to have another one killed tomorrow, we can buy steak at Shepherd now or could two weeks ago for six cents. I have been home sick ever since I got home, it would not do for me to go to Steuben many times or I would want to stay. The girls were pretty tired doing Mother's work while she was away, they did nicely, the very best they could, but I got home tired and we had company and work hands, and the weather so hot, dry and stifling seemed as if I could not keep going to get what was actually necessary to have done, and the water here has seemed too horrid to try to do any thing with, so hard. I hope this will find you all well. I had such a good visit, but I did not stay long enough hardly anywhere to get satisfied. I stopped off at Ella's, we got there the next night after leaving Hornellsville, and then I went down to Mary's and Esther and her boy came there to visit with me. I came home the following Tuesday, father came on with me, he endured the journey better than I for whenever I hear from there he is going somewhere, and I have not been anywhere only to the store until last week, tired out all the time. I feel better since the rain. Mary and Esther and her boy was out here three weeks ago, they were all well then, father thought he would stay with Ella this winter, Tamma and family live at Maple Rapids now. John is in the butchering business yet or was when my sisters were here. Please remember me to Libbie and family, and kind regards to Scott and wife, and Maryett please kiss the two little ones for me, Libbie's baby and Scott's. How is your father and mother now? and do tell me of Harrison, he looked so cute in his grandpa's arms eating with grandpa, and what did they do with those potatoes? and how many potatoes did Stanton have this year? How many potatoes on Edwin's acre? There were a plenty of apples in some places not far from here, sold in the orchards for fifty cents per bushel. The corn crop very short. The larger part of the wheat in this vicinity was so poor and shrunken on account of that freeze last spring, that it was only fit for hog feed, could not make any flour out of it at all. I can't think of anything more that will interest you so will close. With our best wishes for the welfare of yourselves and family, Please write us a letter.

Dear Sister Mary,

Your very welcome letter received one day last week and we was so glad to hear from you but sorry to hear of you getting hurt and you being so poorly. Do hope by the time this reaches you that you will be much better. We came here last November from Muskogee. Bought 80 acres of land and donated 100 acres of State land. But it is rough and hilly but will make us a home if we stay. It is on the Boston mountains. It is very healthy here, but I am not at home among the people. The women chew tobacco and dip snuff, and ask me home with them every time they come. Well when your letter came John and I was alone as Edwin is in Kansas in the wheat harvest, has been gone from home four weeks yesterday. And I tell you I miss him the most of any of the boys. He is always full of fun and is liked by everybody. Ray is just as he used to be has his cranky streaks, he puts us in mind of his grandpa's ways when he was about seventy years old, but if Ray lives to be that old I don't know who can get along with him but I think he will come down a peg or two. He came here from Muskogee in the spring, was home about two months and has been back in Muskogee about a month. Friday we received a letter from him saying he will start for home one week from today. I think you would know him as he has not changed much. He has been having the chills and is as poor as he used to be. Eddie is the largest one of the boys, weighed in the spring 160 lbs. John is very poor in flesh works harder than he ought. Has the rheumatism very bad at times. He is now taking a medicine called Vitae Ore that they claim will cure the rheumatism. Mary we have moved so much that at times I am tired of living and have thought time and again I would surely write to you and Esther and I would be so heartbroken I could not write at all. But don't think I have forgotten you as it is hard for me to write. Poor Esther I feel so sad when I think of her. Does she speak of me when you see her? Has Bus sold his place? How is Ervin and his wife and how many

children have they? Where is Henry and Loren this summer? And Charlie Beattie do you ever hear from him? I think it must be awfully lonely for Frank and the children. Mary we don't know when we are raising our children whether any of them will care for us or not when we get old. It seems so hard that you had to be separated from Emma but that is what I thought when I heard she had married a preacher. Give my love to all the girls and Frank, tell them I often think of them. Mary please excuse this pencil and poor paper as we are out of writing paper and if I wrote now I would have to use this. Your affectionate sister, Tamma

Former Pastor of Sumner Place
E. Church Goes to His Long Rest
—Was a Faithful Servant of the
Church.

Rev. A. T. Cameron, pastor of Sumner Place M. E. Church, received a telegram this morning announcing the death at Angelica last evening of the Rev. Carlos G. Lowell, who has been ill for some time. The intelligence will be received with sincere regret by a large number of former parishioners and friends.

Mr. Lowell, owing to falling health, was forced to abandon the active ministry at the time of the last conference, to take up superannuated relations. He had been in active service of the church for forty years, eight of which were passed in Buffalo, five years as pastor of Woodside M. E. Church and three at Sumner Place. He is survived by his widow and four children, two sons who reside in Buffalo and two daughters in Angelica.

Mr. Lowell was a chaplain in the army during the Civil War, and a pastor of a church in Minnesota during the Indian outbreak. He was a man of clear reasoning, strong character and most delightful personality, making friends of all with whom he came in contact.

The funeral will take place from the home in Angelica on Saturday morning at 11 o'clock.

In the death of Carlos G. Lowell the church loses one of its most devoted and conscientious servants and the community a good citizen whose influence was always for the uplifting of humanity.

The following comments were taken from A HISTORY OF STEUBEN COUNTY, NEW YORK, AND ITS PEOPLE; Irvin W. Near; Volume 11, 1911:

Among the prominent citizens of Hornellsville, New York, is W. W. Babcock, who takes a prominent part in public affairs and is well established in business. His boyhood days were spent in Fremont and he was educated in the public schools. He was reared on a farm and carried on his farm in young manhood. When he started business on his own account he began dealing in monuments, working first as traveling salesman for the Field and Alden Granite Company, with who he remained fourteen years, when he left their employ to engage in business on his own account. He is a expert in his line, having been engaged in the business as salesman and proprietor about thirty-two years. He has been very successful in establishing himself in the esteem and confidence of the people of his vicinity, and besides this business owns a farm of one hundred and twelve acres near by, which is mostly devoted to grain. He rents this land to good advantage. Mr. Babcock is a member of the I.O.O.F. and is very active in church work, having been a trustee of the Methodist Episcopal Church for about fifteen years. He has been a lifelong Republican and has taken great interest in public and political affairs, and has held various offices. He has served as town clerk and commissioner of highways, has been postmaster of Fremont and is now a member of the board of public works of Hornell. He has always supported every cause which he considered for the benefit and welfare of the community, and is looked upon with great respect by all who know him. About 1875, while Mr. Babcock was carrying on his farm, he lost his left arm in a threshing machine. However, in spite of this misfortune, he continues in excellent health and is as much interested as ever in matters of public moment.

The first land records in Michigan of our Marquis Phillips are in 1874 in Huron County, where on March 25, M. L. Phillips purchased 80 acres in the east half of the south east quarter of Section 15, Township 16, North Range 15 East, from Byron and Hannah Bartlett.

The land, situated in Sand Beach (now called Harbor Beach), was purchased for six hundred dollars.

In 1875, Marquis's brother, Elisha, followed him into Michigan. On February 8, 1875, M. L. Phillips of Sand Beach sold to Elisha Phillips of Steuben County, New York, the north-east quarter of the south-east quarter of Section 15, Township 16, North of Range 15 east (40 acres) for three hundred dollars. On April 6, 1877, Elisha sold this same land to Charles Mitchell.

The indenture states that Elisha Phillips was of Sand Beach, Huron County, Michigan; he later sold the land for one hundred and twenty-five dollars - far less than he had paid for it.

Family history records that Elisha lived at home following his father's death, until Maranda remarried. Perhaps the second marriage took place around 1875, and this prompted Elisha to leave home and seek out his older brother in Huron County, Michigan. It remains unknown at this time why Elisha sold out or where he went.

In 1875, Marquis married Adeline Ingles of Sand Beach, daughter of Philip and Sara Caves Ingles. They were married by the Baptist minister, Mr. A. M. Swain.

There is a discrepancy also in the spelling of Adeline. Some family records have the name spelled with a second "a", Adaline. It is spelled "Adaline" on her marriage certificate, and one might suppose she had something to do with the preparation of that document. "Adeline" was chosen in this work because it is the most common spelling. Most of the family spell it Adeline, though the Deckerville Recorder newspaper names her "Adelia" in the obituary for Marquis.

Marquis and Adeline established their home on land that had been burned over in the fire of 1871, when Adeline's family had been saved from the flames by her elder brother, Edmund.

Adeline and Marquis lived in Sand Beach until 1880 when, with three small children, they moved to New York. They remained there until 1882. Shortly after Frank was born, they moved back to Sand Beach, Michigan, with little Frank crying all the way. Apparently, they had not sold their Michigan land, for in 1884, Marquis sold part of the Sand Beach property on 24 October, 1884, to Adeline's two brothers, John H. and Wellington Ingles. John paid one hundred and seventy-five dollars for the east half, and Wellington paid the same amount for the west half; each parcel was about ten acres.

In 1885, Marquis, Adeline and their five children moved to Wheatland Township, Sanilac County, four miles west of Deckerville. Marquis homesteaded the land, eventually building a two story, seven room log cabin on the property. He left his family in Sand Beach while he was building the first floor rooms, walking back and forth the more than twenty miles between Wheatland and Sand Beach.

With a team of oxen named "Dime" and "Duke", Marquis farmed his homestead on burned-over land from the Great Fire of 1881. Adeline kept house, caring for their family of eleven children, one of whom died in infancy.

They remained at Wheatland for twenty years until in 1905, Marquis purchased a farm at Wadhams, a small town west of Port Huron. The family lived at Wadhams for the next thirteen years. Then in 1918, they moved to Scott Avenue in Port Huron, so that their youngest child, Ethel, could attend high school in the city.

Being a skillful carpenter, Marquis went about the Port Huron area in his horse-drawn wagon doing odd jobs - a much needed occupation with so many younger men away from home during the World War I years.

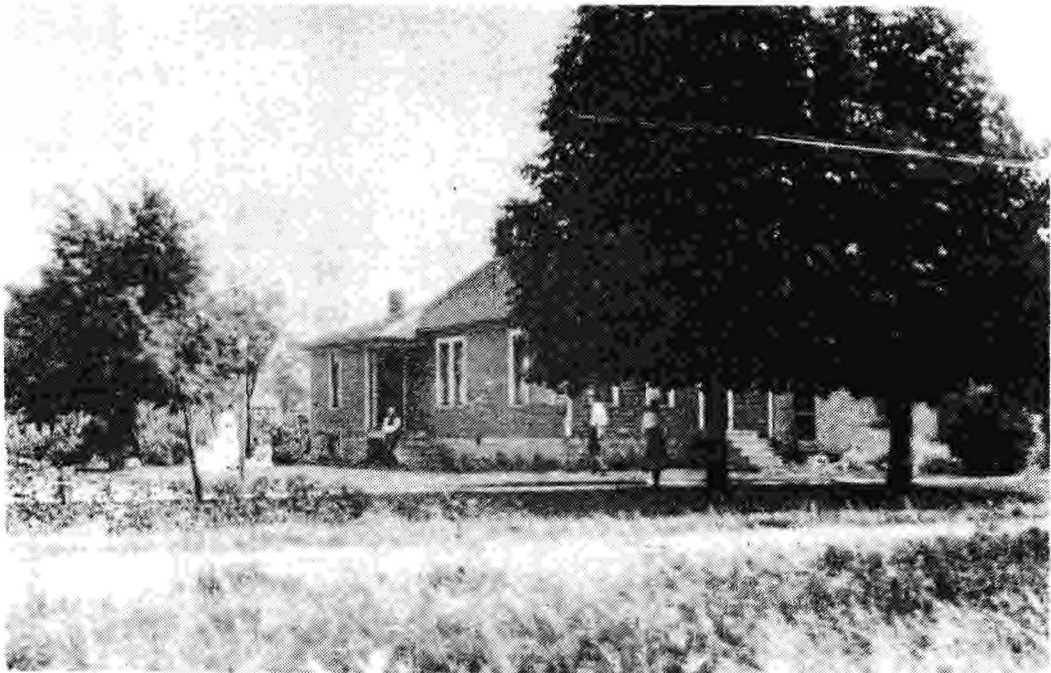
It was the Wadhams home that the children returned to for visits and to establish a tradition of family reunions that lasted until 1963.

Cedar Rapids, Iowa
June 26, 1881

Dear Cousin,

Your letter received. Was very glad to hear from you again. I have thought of you a number of times since I wrote you last and wondered how you were prospering. I have intended to write to you before this for I sent some things by Aunt Ermine Young when she went home for you and Libbie and Aunts. I marked them all I believe. Mother told me before she died to give her black silk shawl to Aunt Ruth so I sent it with some neck ties of Mother's and mine and I had made a light blue beau for Libbie and when some of you are in H'ville call at Mr. Finches' and they will give them to you. When Pa and I were in Chicago in March we met Aunt and she came home with me. I visited Uncle James Palmer's at Elgin while I was gone. Pa has relatives in Chicago that we visited. I am enjoying myself this summer very much. I was at Anamosa Decoration time. I went over to visit Mother's grave and have it fixed up some. I set out some plants and decoration day I covered the grave with evergreen and put a large bouquet on the grave and I made an anchor of evergreen and then put clusters of scarlet geraniums and silver leaves here and there on the anchor and hung it on the monument and it looked very pretty. How strange life seems to me, sometime to think that is all I can do in memory of my Mother. It does seem hard to think that Mother could not live a few years longer and had health but I would not want to call her back to suffer as she did so long before she went home. Oh, how thankful I am for my good health. Pa has had one sick spell this Spring. I was quite alarmed about him but he is quite well now. Yes, this is a beautiful time of year. I looked around me often this Spring and exclaimed to myself how beautiful this world is when clothed in her green robe of Spring time and how enjoyable when one has health. I have just returned from a very pleasant little trip. My sister-in-law Mrs. Frank Austin has been visiting me and we went to Iowa City, it is about 35 miles from here, to attend the commencement exercise and visit our Uncle by marriage. Iowa City is a beautiful city, the State University grounds are perfectly beautiful, we were gone nearly a week. My sister used to go to school at the University. I never was in the city before. Pa says he does not know where you could get those fluting irons for he bought them of an agent. I have one and Mother had one and I will send you hers if you would like to have it. Perhaps by the time you paid the freight on it down there it would be more than it is worth but you can write and tell me. We are having a great amount of rain this month. You ask me if I am ever going east. I think I will if I live long enough. I often wonder if any of you will ever come west. I do wish that you and Cousin John would, it would do you both a world of good. Write to me soon, tell Libbie and Scott I should be delighted to hear from them. Pa joins in sending love to all.

I spent a few days at Anamosa, found Grandma's health quite good for her. Aunt Ermine, Uncle James and all of us have been trying to persuade Grandma to go east and live with Aunt Ermine or Uncle James this fall but she did not want to leave her cozy home. I received a line from a friend of mine today and she had been up to see Grandma and she said she might conclude to rent her house and store her goods next year and live with her children if I would go east with her. I should like to go very much. I would enjoy visiting you all very much. I hope Scott will come this far west this fall and make us a visit, we should like to see him very much. I enjoyed my trip this fall out to Council Bluffs and DesMoines. I never had been west of CR before, I tell you we have a fine State, it is so well improved. DesMoines is a lovely city and growing very rapidly, all the improvements throughout the State are substantial, every town of any size has a fine looking school building and other public buildings according. I enjoy traveling very much, one sees so much to interest them and can glean so much knowledge that they would not otherwise gain. I am back in the store as usual. Pa is very busy this fall, his business seems to be increasing, he is well as usual. I will send you in this letter a picture of Mother and one of my Husband. I have not got any of myself but will send you one as soon as I have some taken, of course Mother's and my Husband's pictures are copied pictures but they are very good, we have a good one of Mother in India ink large size. I am sorry to learn of Aunt Mary's ill health, when you write please tell me how she is. Give my love to all who inquire. Hoping this will find you all enjoying good health, I close with love,

Dear Cousin Maryett,

Your kind and welcome letter received a few weeks ago and I intended answering before this but I do not seem to find time to write letters now days. I have intended to write you all winter and when I sent Austin's picture I thought sure I would write soon and tell Libbie to excuse me for not writing to her when I sent that box but I had been so long in sending it that I concluded I would not wait any longer even if I did not write anything when I sent it. I suppose she received it all right did she not? I sent it I think about the time I did the picture to you. I am not certain as to the exact time. We received their wedding cards and the paper containing the marriage. Yes, indeed, you must miss Libbie. I have thought of you often this winter. I hope she has as good a husband as he has a wife and I trust she has. I liked his appearance when I visited you. I am glad they have settled near you so you can see her often and

Scott being so near you can see them all so often. I do not know as I will get this written very plain as I am tending store, and the baby this afternoon and trying to write this. Edward is up home working, we have a clerk that goes to school so is not here all the time, so if Edward does anything at home I have to come down here, so take the house, store, and baby it keeps both busy and I have done all my work all winter. I expect to have some help the last of this week just to help me through house cleaning. I have had two or three music scholars all winter and still have so you can see why I do not get much spare time and I was not very well during February. Austin is so big and heavy that he tires me to take care of him but I am feeling real well now. I have been taking tonic. Austin has been real well all winter and is now. I do hope you and Cousin John will come west next year, I should enjoy a visit from you so much. That is sad about Uncle Asa, he must suffer a great deal for I believe that everyone that has a cancer suffers untold agonies for Mother said during her last sickness that death could not be any worse than the suffering she had just past through. How I should like to visit you all again. Edward often talks of going east but it all depends upon our business whether we go very soon. Aunt Ruth Pope made me a short visit last week before last on her way home from Cedar Rapids, she had been attending the G.A.R. reunion. They are talking some of going east this summer. I was sorry I could not send one of Austin's pictures to Aunt Ruth, Uncle Asa, and Aunt Emeline but I thought they could all see it at your house. We did not feel as though we could afford to any more just at present. Did I ever send you one of Edward's pictures? And did I send his to Aunt Ruth? Uncle Asa? and Aunt Emeline? I have forgotten. I promised some of his pictures and I do not remember whether I ever sent all I promised or not. We are having nice weather here, we expect to have quite a garden this summer, it has been grubbed and broke up this spring and the soil is very rich up on that side hill, you would not call it a side hill in New York for it would not be any hill at all beside of your hills. Tell Libbie I know that I have not answered her letter but I will sometime but I should enjoy hearing from her in the meantime. Aunt Ermine (Young) Pennicario (?) has moved to Connecticut. I have not your letter here so I may not write all I want to but I will not wait. I am going to mail this today for I have been so long about it. I wish you would just drop me a postal and let me know if Libbie got the box, there has been so many packages lost of late that perhaps she did not get it. I sent a blue plush case containing a comb, brush, and hand glass. I ought to have written to her and told her if she had a duplicate that I would send something else if that is the case let me know and I will arrange the matter. Give my love to all. Edward joins me in sending love to all.

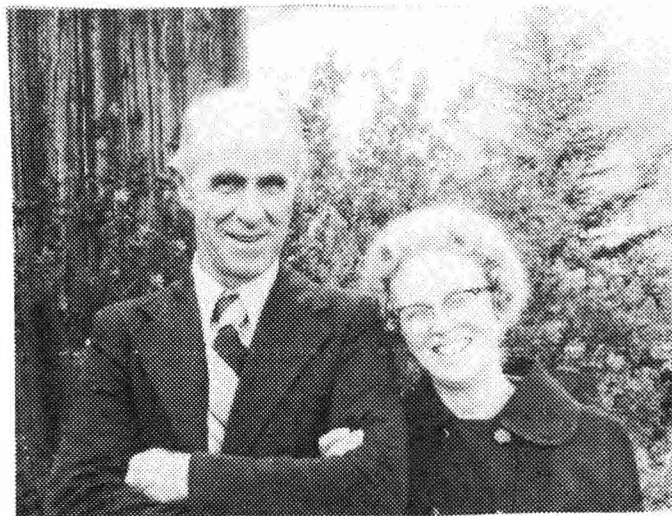
