My feoffees to enfeoff John my younger son at full age in the manors of Ramseye, Wreabness &

Essex - He is also to have surrender of a ten^t with 'kaya'
in the suburbs of Colchester which Richard Stodole &
Johanna his wife hold for life

John my elder son to have surrender of all my manors
in Essex & in Kent with advowson etc when he comes of
age which my wife Elizabeth holds for life by fine -
All manors etc assigned above to John my elder son at
full age for the term of life of my wife shall at her death
be settled on John my younger son & his heirs - if John the
elder die in Elizabeth's life then my feoffees shall enfeoff
John the younger in all manors etc which were assigned
above to John the elder -

If John the younger die without heir in life time of
John the elder, the latter to have all lands assigned to the former -
if both die in Elizabeth's life time, then all lands assigned
them to be sold except the manor of Ghishull Parva which
is assigned to my right heirs
