Comments: HENDEE, GEORGE WHITMAN, lawyer, state senator, congressman, governor, was born Nov. 30, 1832, in Stowe, Vt. He was prosecuting attorney in 1858; a member of the state house of representatives in 1861 and 1862; and of the state senate in 1866, 1867, and 1868. He was lieutenant-governor of Vermont in 1869; was governor in 1870; and was elected to the forty-third, forty-fourth and forty-fifth congresses as a republican.
