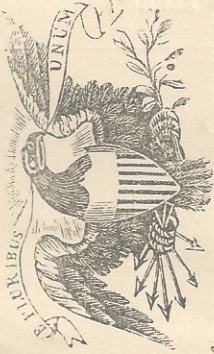

Know Ye, That Joel Whiting a Private of Captain
W. Williams Company (A one Hundredth Regiment of New York Infantry Volunteers,
 who was enrolled on the nineteenth day of August, one thousand eight hundred and Sixty Six
 to serve Three Years is hereby, with his own consent, discharged from the service of the United States,
 this Fifth day of January, 1863, at Alexandria Va
 by reason of Surgeon's Certificate of Disability. This Discharge shall be without prejudice to the right of this Soldier,
 to the arrears of pay or allowances which may be found due him, in addition to the pay and allowances received at the
 time of his Discharge; which are shown by the Statement on the back of this Discharge.

(No objection to his being re-enlisted is known to exist.)*

Said Joel Whiting was born in Meber in the
 State of New York, is Twenty Three years of age, Five feet
Eight inches high, Light eyes, Light hair, and by occupation,
 when enrolled, at Harrods

GIVEN at Alexandria Va this Fifth day of January 1863

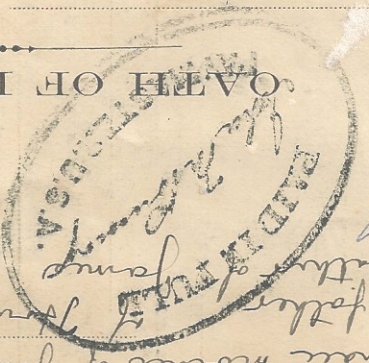
